Science degree in accounting from the University
of Central Oklahoma and a Master of Accoun-
tancy degree from the University of Oklahoma.

COCONUT PUDDING DESSERT.

- Serves 10 to 12
- 3 ea 13.5-ounce cans coconut milk
 - 3 cups skim milk + 1 cup to mix corn starch
 - 4 cups 2% milk
 - 2 cups sugar
 - 1 teaspoon salt
 - 12 oz cornstarch + 1 cup milk

1. In a saucepan, combine the coconut milk with the sugar, milks and salt. Bring to a full boil and cook for about 6 minutes, stirring occasionally. In a bowl, combine the cornstarch with 1 cup milk and, with a whisk, mix well into a slurry. Immediately pour the slurry into the saucepan and cook, continuously whisking until the mixture thickens into a pudding, about 2 minutes. Remove from the heat.
2. Transfer the strained pudding into a nonstick 12"x6" deep dish or into individual martini glasses. Smooth out the surface, and set aside to cool. Refrigerate to completely set, about 2 hours.
